- **Promotion, Marketing and Sponsorship expenditure** includes design, production and distribution of fund marketing, advertising development and media costs as well as payments to our distribution partners. Expenditure in this category helps to promote and grow the fund. The Fund's size and scale enables access to investment opportunities and helps keep fees as low as possible for fund members. Estimates are used in the calculation of this expenditure. The estimates are based on assumptions which in our view are reasonable having regard to latest available information as at the date of this Notice. - **Related party payments** occur when payments are made from the MST to Mercer related entities for the provision of services for the MST. 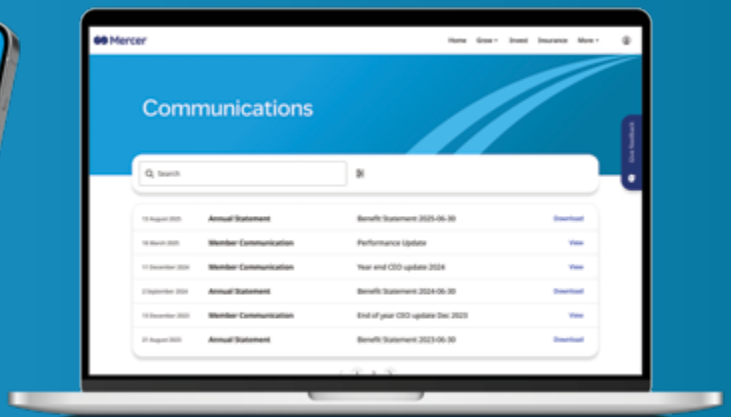
