
Economic review

Australia: The Reserve Bank of Australia (RBA) cut the cash rate to 3.6%

- The RBA cut the cash rate by 0.25% to 3.6%, over the quarter. The RBA remained focused on international developments and uncertainties in the domestic economy, despite the labour market remaining tight.
- The unemployment rate fell to 4.2% in Q3'25, from 4.3%; the labor market showed signs of softening, with only 23,200 jobs added during the quarter. There was a noticeable shift from full-time to part-time positions and the participation rate ended the quarter lower at 66.8%.
- Australian Q2'25 Gross Domestic Product (GDP) grew at 0.6%, slightly above market expectations.
 This stronger growth partly reflected a rebound from the weaker performance in Q1'25, which was
 impacted by tropical cyclone Alfred.
- Australia's Q2'25 inflation data indicated a continued decline in inflation. Headline Consumer Price Index (CPI) for the Q2'25 was 2.1%, down from 2.4% in Q1'25 and below the consensus estimate of 2.2% Year-on-Year (YoY). Core CPI also eased to 2.7%, from 2.9% matching consensus expectations.

International: Central banks continue to cut rates

- Most central banks continued to cut rates during Q3'25 (with the US Federal Reserve (Fed), the Bank of Canada (BOC) and the Bank of England (BoE) cutting rates by 0.25% over the quarter); while the European Central Bank (ECB) held rates steady.
- The US economy maintained its growth momentum in Q2'25, with GDP increasing by 3%. This growth was partly driven by a rebound following the front loading of imports ahead of the tariffs introduced in Q1'25. Net exports were robust due to weaker import demand, and private inventories saw a significant rise. However, domestic demand growth slowed, signaling a potential slowdown in the economy.
- The US labour market continued to soften; with payroll data for the quarter showing 88,000 jobs added, below market expectations of 220,000. The unemployment rate increased to 4.2% from 4.1% in the prior quarter.
- NZ economic growth slowed significantly in Q2'25, as global geopolitical tensions derailed NZ's recovery. NZ GDP fell by -0.9% Quarter-on-Quarter (QoQ) in Q2'25, whilst expectations were for a decline of only -0.3%. Market expectations now reflect the likelihood of two interest rate cuts in 2025.

Market review

A strong quarter for International shares

- International shares (hedged) increased by 7.6% in Q3'25, despite disappointing US economic data. Several investments in the US tech sector saw the Mag 7 shares (Apple, Microsoft, Amazon, Alphabet, Meta, Tesla, and Nvidia) rise by 17.6% during the quarter.
- Emerging market shares (unhedged) rose 9.4%, driven by a 20.7% rise in the Chinese share market during the quarter.

Australian shares edged higher

- Australian shares were up 5% in Q3'25. Most sectors recorded gains. The materials sector delivered the strongest performance; rising 19.4%, as metal prices surged. The healthcare sector was the weakest; declining by -10.5%, after the US administration announced tariffs on pharmaceutical imports.
- Meanwhile Australian small cap shares rose 15.3% for the quarter.

Commodities and precious metals prices rise


- · Most commodities strengthened during the quarter; except energy prices, which declined.
- Precious metals posted a strong quarter; with gold up 16.8%, silver rising 16%, and gains also seen in copper and aluminium.

International fixed interest returns were positive, Australian bonds flat

- International government bonds (hedged) gained 0.5% in Q3'25. US yields dropped 0.8% to 4.15%, due to a weaker labour market; while yields in most other countries increased.
- International credit (hedged) was up 2.0%, as credit spreads narrowed.
- Australian government bonds returned 0% in Q3'25, as the rise in the 10-year bond yield offset any gains.

US Dollar (USD) showed signs of recovery

After experiencing its weakest half-year performance since 1991, the USD rising by 0.9% in Q3'25. Other
major currencies showed mixed results against the USD; the Euro (EUR) declined by -0.4%, the British
Pound (GBP) fell by -2.1%, and the Japanese Yen (JPY) dropped by -2.6%. However, the AUD rose 0.5%
against the USD during the quarter.






